Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 67 dated 30.3.2017, registered under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC at Police Station City Jagraon, Ludhiana.

On 21.3.2018, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was granted bail on 03.05.2017 and thereafter, he was appearing regularly in the Court. On account of committal of the case to the court of Sessions, he could not get the relevant information as he was appearing in person.

Now, nonbailable warrants have been issued against the petitioner for 21.04.2018.

Notice of motion for 02.05.2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on the date already fixed. In the event of his appearance, he shall be granted interim bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that pursuant to order dated 21.3.2018, petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court on 21.4.2018 and has been granted interim bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana. This fact has been admitted by learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh.

In view of aforesaid, interim order dated 21.3.2018 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
