Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in complaint No.122 dated 10.06.2015, whereby the petitioners have summoned under Sections 3(i)(x) of The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (for short 'SC&ST Act') and Sections 504/506 IPC and subsequently non-bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioners.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the order dated 21.03.2018, petitioners have already appeared before the trial Court on 26.03.2018 and are released on interim bail.

The aforesaid factual position is not disputed by learned State counsel.
