ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 26, dated 28.02.2018, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 326, 427 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury, which is attributed to the petitioner, is on the little finger of the left hand of the complainant.

A Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 21.03.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Baldev Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 21.03.2018, the

petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner having joined investigation and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 21.03.2018, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
