This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioners under Sections 353, 186, 436, 427, 34, 148, 149, 120-B, 188 IPC, Sections 3, 4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984, and Section 3, 4 of the Explosive Substances Act, 1908 (Sections 148, 149, 120-B, 188 IPC, Section 4 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984, and Sections 3, 4 of the Explosive Substance Act, 1908 added later on), at Police Station Sadar Budhlada, District Mansa, vide FIR No.73 dated 25.08.2017.

Petitioners are stated to be in custody for more than five months. They are not named in the FIR. Their names figured during the course of investigation. Investigation has been completed and challan has been presented before the trial court. So, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioners in custody any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.
