The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.54 dated 17.05.2017 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 324, 326, 452 & 34 of Indian Penal Code (Section 326 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda and all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 13.09.2018, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, who was directed to record their statements and submit report to this Court.

Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phul has been received that statement of the injured-Jagroop Singh as well as the accused has been recorded and compromise deed-Ex.Cx is produced. He

has reported that both the parties have effected compromise which is voluntary and without any pressure, threat or coercion. Case is stated to be still pending at investigation stage.

It being so, FIR No.54 dated 17.05.2017 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 324, 326, 452 & 34 of Indian Penal Code (Section 326 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda along with consequential proceedings, stands quashed qua the petitioners.

Accordingly, petition is allowed.
