Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for a direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect his life and liberty and his family members, who are being threatened by private respondent Nos.5 and 6. Respondent Nos.5 and 6 are accused in FIR No.280 dated 18.09.2017 under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Julana, District Jind.

Memo of appearance filed on behalf of respondent Nos.4 and 5 and power of attorney filed on behalf of respondent No.6 are taken on record.

It has been alleged in the petition that respondent Nos.5 and 6 in connivance with respondent No.4-Ram Kishan Jangra, Assistant Sub-Inspector, Police Station Julana, are pressurizing the petitioner to enter into a compromise to withdraw the FIR.

On notice of motion having been issued, reply has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. The reply is signed by the Superintendent of Police, Jind.

Learned State Counsel while making reference to Annexure R-1 communication sent by the Superintendent of Police, Jind to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, City Jind, states that the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jind, has been directed to ensure protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members and the petitioner shall not be harassed at the instance of any police officials.

Considering the categorical stand of respondent Nos.1 to 3, this Court finds that prayer of the petitioner is meticulously met with. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of. The Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jind, shall adhere to the directions issued by the Superintendent of Police, Jind, as referred in Annexure R-1.

Disposed of accordingly.
