This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Section 22/61/85 Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Kotwali, District Kapurthala, vide FIR No.154 dated 15.5.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that recovery of 115 grams intoxicating powder containing Alprazolam, which is marginally above commercial quantity. He further contends that there is no other case pending against the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer.

In view of above, I find that no useful purpose will be served in continuing the detention of the petitioner. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without making any observation on the merits of this case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the satisfaction of the concerned trial court/Illaq Magistrate.
