This petition had been filed seeking anticipatory bail through the attorney in case FIR No.203 dated 06.08.2005 registered under Sections 406/498-A/354/509/420/120-B IPC at Police Station Mohali, District Ropar (now S.A.S. Nagar Mohali)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that a separate petition had been filed by the parents of the petitioner for quashing of FIR and one petition was filed by the petitioner's brother and the Court had directed the the husband (petitioner) to come present to see if an amicable settlement could be effected and therefore the petitioner had come to India and the petitioner filed a separate petition for quashing of the Proclamation Order and this Court had stayed the operation of that order and the petitioner came

to India and joined the investigation and subsequently had been appearing in the Court but the wife failed to appear despite directions of this Court. The counsel states that he does not want to proceed further with this petition and wants to withdraw the petition.
