The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.18 dated 27.02.2017, registered under Sections 379, 411 IPC at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Harpal Singh, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 06.04.2017, passed by this Court is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
