This petition has been filed to set aside orders dated 28.11.2017 and 08.03.2018 (Annexures P-4 and P-5) vide which conditional warrants qua the petitioner have been issued as he has not deposited the arrears of maintenance in terms of order dated 03.06.2015.

It is contended that the impugned orders have been wrongly passed without advertence to the provisions of law.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to deny that the petitioner is indeed in arrears of maintenance. Order dated 03.06.2015 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patti, vide which maintenance in favour of the respondent-wife and three minor children was awarded has not been challenged by the petitioner. He has accepted the said order. Therefore, it does not lie with the petitioner to desist from depositing the maintenance regularly on one hand and on the other hand challenge orders dated 28.11.2017 and

08.03.2018 issuing conditional warrants on frivolous grounds. In fact the respondent-wife and minor children are made to face unnecessary harassment due to the conduct of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to point out any illegality, infirmity or perversity in the impugned orders dated 28.11.2017 and 08.03.2018 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patti.

No ground whatsoever is made out for interference by this Court in exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr. P.C.

This petition is accordingly dismissed.
