This is the petition that has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect life, liberty and property of the petitioner and further for issuance of direction to respondents No. 1 to 4 to get the the complaint dated 27.2.2017 made by respondent No. 6 against the petitioner inquired expeditiously.

Pursuant to the notice issued to the respondents, reply by way of affidavit of Ranjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Rural), Pathankot has been filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 5. The same is taken on record.

In the reply, it is stated that on a complaint that had been filed

by respondent No. 6-Parmila Devi, an inquiry was marked to the Superintendent of Police, Traffic and Security, Pathankot, who conducted a detailed inquiry in the matter and recorded the statements of the parties and the witnesses by visiting the spot. The petitioner was directed to appear before the Inquiry Officer, who thereafter came to the conclusion that all the allegations levelled by the complainant—Parmila Devi were not substantiated and, therefore, it has been recommended that the application be disposed of.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent—State submits that in view of the inquiry report, no action is proposed to be taken on the application so filed by respondent No.6.

Since the matter has been inquired into and the allegations made in the application so moved by respondent No. 6 were not substantiated, no further orders are called for. The petition is disposed of accordingly.
