Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.107 dated 17.12.2016 under Section 15 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 19.12.2016 and the case is still at the stage of recording the prosecution evidence. It is further submitted that there are moot points involved in the case with regard to sending the sample to the FSL and non-joining of second Investigating Officer, to be decided during the course of trial. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manjit Singh, has submitted that four prosecution witnesses have been examined, out of 13 PWs

and one PW has been given up by the prosecution.

Without commenting anything further on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody for the last 01 year and 08 months; the case is still at the stage of recording the prosecution evidence and the petitioner is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
