The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 16 dated 23.01.2017, registered under Sections 302, 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that only Lalkara is attributed to the petitioner. No injury is alleged to have caused by him. Apart from that all the material witnesses have turned hostile. PW-3 Amrinder Singh allegedly injured in the assault has not supported the prosecution version, neither have PW-4 Dharminder Singh and PW-7 Gurpreet Singh (complainant). Thus, it is prayed that the petitioner be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute that the material witnesses have turned hostile. He also does not dispute the fact that no injury is attributed to the petitioner.

Keeping in view the totality of the facts and circumstances of this case and also that the petitioner has been in custody since 11.04.2017, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. The petition is allowed and the

petitioner – Gurjant Singh @ Janti is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
