The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 43 dated 26.04.2017, registered under Sections 302, 34 IPC at Police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the main accused has been granted regular bail vide order dated 08.03.2018 and, thus, the petitioner is also entitled to grant of regular bail on the principle of parity.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the factual submissions made hereinabove.

Custody certificate dated 28.03.2018 prepared by Sh. Rajiv Kumar Arora, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

According to this certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of ten months and twenty five days. There is no other case pending against him.

Keeping in view the totality of the facts and circumstances of this case and also the fact that the main accused has been granted regular bail vide order dated 08.03.2018, it would be just and appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner as well. The petition is allowed and the petitioner – Sukhdev Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
