Though learned counsel for the petitioner has again submitted that the petitioner was only the person who introduced the complainant to one Paramjit Singh, who was running 'Singh Tours and Travels' at Jagraon, and Paramjit Singh as a matter of fact has been admitted to bail by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, learned State counsel points to the fact that the petitioner in fact even returned Rs.1 lac to the complainant, thereby obviously showing that money had been taken from the complainant on the promise of getting him a work permit in South Africa, but with him having been sent instead on a tourist visa to Dubai.

That being so, and the incidence of people being duped in such like manner being on the rise, without making any comment on the actual involvement or otherwise of the petitioner in the commission of the crime as has been alleged, I do not think this is not an appropriate case where the

petitioner.

Consequently, finding no merit in the petition, it is dismissed, with the interim order dated March 26, 2018 vacated.

However, as already stated, nothing stated hereinabove will be taken either by the investigating agency or the competent Court (at the appropriate stage), to be an observation of this Court on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner.
