Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.129 dated 22.07.2017, under Sections 147/148/149/452/506/307 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Siwani, District Bhiwani.

Counsel for the parties have been heard at length.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Suman Devi in relation to an alleged occurrence dated 22.07.2017. Injured is Rajesh i.e. husband of the complainant and who was fired upon and has suffered two fire arm injuries. Main accused is Ram Niwas i.e. brother of the injured and who fired a shot which hit on the right side of the jaw. The second fire arm injury is on the left arm of Rajesh and which as per prosecution is attributed to Shyama (non-applicant).

Present petitioner is stated to be present at the time of occurrence along with the accused party.

Petitioner was arrested on 13.08.2017.

Investigation qua the present petitioner is complete and challan

already stands presented.

Trial would take time to conclude.

Petitioner otherwise has clean antecedents and is not involved in any other case.

Without making any observations on merits and keeping in view the length of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, he is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
