Instant petition was preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.17 dated 26.01.2018, under Sections 406/420/465/467/471 IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur.

Briefly noticed FIR was registered on the allegation that the complainant had been duped of a sum of Rs.4,50,000/- approximately by the petitioner/accused on the pretext of getting employment in the Indian Railways.

The instant petition came up for preliminary hearing on 22.03.2018 and counsel representing the petitioner had sought time to complete instructions with regard to the readiness and willingness of the petitioner to furnish a demand draft of Rs.2 lacs in the name of the complainant towards part settlement of the dispute.

Time was granted and matter was adjourned to 27.03.2018.

During the course of resumed hearing on 27.03.2018, counsel furnished an undertaking on behalf of the petitioner Bhupinder Singh who was also present in Court that Rs.2 lacs would be deposited with the Registry of this Court on or before 13.04.2018.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the undertaking has not been fulfilled and the amount of Rs.2 lacs has not been deposited.

Against the backdrop of the allegations and the conduct of the petitioner having furnished an undertaking before this Court and having deviated therefrom, he is not entitled to the concession of pre arrest bail.

Petition dismissed.
