Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0042 dated 06.6.2017, under Sections 302, 201, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Bariwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

It was pursuant to an order passed by the trial Court in terms of Section 319 Cr.P.C. that the petitioner was summoned to face trial for offences punishable under Sections 302 and 201 read with Section 34 IPC along with other accused against whom challan has already been presented.

Pursuant to directions issued by this Court on 04.5.2018 the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and furnished bail bonds and

surety bonds. In fact pursuant to his appearance charges have also been framed.

In view of the aforesaid position, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner behind the bars at this stage. The petition, as such is accepted and the the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 04.5.2018 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall continue to appear regularly before the trial Court.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
