The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.471, dated 12.11.2017, under Section 21 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Barwala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that 200 grams smack have been recovered from the petitioner, which is non-commercial quantity. Investigation is complete and challan has already been presented. The petitioner is in custody since 12.11.2017 and therefore, no useful purpose would be served by retaining her in custody. Thus, the petitioner is entitled to grant of regular bail.

3. Learned State counsel does not dispute the fact that the investigation is complete and that quantity recovered from him is non-commercial in nature.

4. In view of the above, it would be just and appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is

ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court concerned at Hisar.
