Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 23.03.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated. Counsel states that there have returned all the articles.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that all their articles have not been returned. However, two bangles of the petitioner's side are with them.

There is dispute about the articles. The complainant/respondent No.2 will have to prove it at the time of trial.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 23.03.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
