The present petition filed under Section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code (for short 'Cr.P.C.') for issuance of direction to the Station House Officer/Arresting Officer of Police Station Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar to release the petitioner on bail in the event of her arrest in FIR No.2 dated 03.01.2017, Police Station Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Both the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel have submitted that petitioner-Seema Rani wife of Deepak Kumar has since died on 9th November, 2014, the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has become infructuous.
