Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the specific allegation against the petitioner is a baseball bat injury on the head of the complainant, the medical evidence shows no such injury at all.

Further, he submits that the petitioner was named by the complainant only four days after the FIR was registered, in a supplementary statement, to the effect that his family advised him that if he knew the assailants he must name them.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual involvement or not of the petitioner in the occurrence, which would be gone into by the trial Court, I consider it appropriate to admit the petitioner to bail, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
