Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed praying for setting aside the impugned order dated 30.01.2018 (**Annexure P-2**), passed in FIR No.22 dated 22.04.2015, under Sections 323, 307, 342, 365, 295, 382, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Talwandi Chaudhrian, District Kapurthala, vide which the petitioner was ordered to be summoned through non-bailable warrants of arrest due to his non-presence in the Court on that day.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the petitioner has been granted regular bail by the learned trial Court.
