The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.157 dated 10.11.2016, registered under Sections 307, 326, 324, 323, 341, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Division No.2, Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Parminder Kaur, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

The matter has already been compromised. Vide Session Case No.279 of 2017 decided on 08.12.2017, the co-accused have already been acquitted.

In this view of the matter, the petition stands allowed and the interim order dated 28.03.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
