AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court for grant of regular bail by filing this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, in FIR No.225, dated 29.08.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Narwana, under Sections 307 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and 25/54/59 of Arms Act.

It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the allegation against the petitioner is only limited to being present at the spot when the offence is alleged to have been committed by the co-accused, who has fired with a pistol, which also did not hit any person. Counsel further states that the petitioner is in custody since 25.10.2017 and the trial is not likely to conclude soon. He, therefore, prays for grant of regular bail to the petitioner during the pendency of the trial.

Counsel for the State could not dispute the fact with regard to

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allegation levelled against the petitioner, on instructions from ASI Balwan Singh, Police Station Sadar Narwana. He further states that charges in this case have not been framed and the next date of hearing before the trial Court is 12.04.2018.

Keeping in view the allegation levelled against the petitioner and the facts that he is in custody since 25.10.2017 and the trial is not likely to conclude soon, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
