The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.448 dated 27th October, 2017, registered under Sections 307, 394, 511, 34, 120-B, 201 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Sonipat, District Sonipat.

Perused Case Diary.

The petitioner was arrested on 16th November, 2017.

It transpires that the petitioner himself was not

personally involved in the actual occurrence of assault as a Security Guard in the Cash van and his involvement is limited to being a planner behind the screen. The material available against him however is based upon the disclosure statements of the other accused persons alone which *per se* would not be admissible.

In the given circumstances, considering the detention undergone by the present petitioner, he may be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sonipat with a further direction to report at the concerned Police Station once a week till such time as thought fit and proper by the Ld. Trial Court after the mater actually comes up for trial post-commitment.
