Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.136 dated 05.12.2017, registered under Section 20 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Buria, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that 700 grams of charas has been recovered from the petitioner which is intermediate quantity/non-commercial. Challan has already been presented. Petitioner is in custody since 05.12.2017.

The aforesaid statement of facts have not been disputed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI

Mehma Singh. Learned State counsel also submitted that the FSL report is still awaited.

At this stage, without adverting to the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail, who is in custody since 05.12.2017.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
