The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect life, liberty and property of the petitioner from respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioners urges that the petitioner has already submitted a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, but no action has been taken thereon and prays that the respondents be directed to decide the said representation expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mrs. Anju Arora, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioners dated 11.2.2018 (Annexure P/5) within a period of eight weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied

to her during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 11.2.2018 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
