Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, does not deny that the complainant has now been examined (including cross-examination).

Singh and Joga Singh, being only a *lalkara* (exhortation) as per the FIR, with them having been in custody for between 3½ to 4 years, and the co-accused having been already admitted to bail vide orders passed in different petitions by this Court, without making any comment on the actual culpability or otherwise of the petitioners, which whould be gone into by the trial Court on the basis of evidence led, these petitions are allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be admitted to bail upon their furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of that Court.
