Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.292 dated 10.09.2015 under Sections 419, 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Kaithal City, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 21.04.2016 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation. He further submits that specimen signatures of the petitioner were taken by the prosecution agency and the same were sent to CFSL for onward comparison and the signatures of the petitioner matches with that of the answer sheet.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Vilasha Ram, does not dispute the aforesaid facts and fairly states that the specimen signatures of the petitioner were sent to CFSL and the same matched with that of the answer sheet.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 21.04.2016 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
