Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to entertain the complaint/representation dated 10.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioner on the basis of the fact that an agreement to sell was entered into between him and respondent Nos.4 to 8 for purchase of a plot, for which advance money of ₹4,50,000/- was also taken and commission of ₹20,000/- was also paid to respondent Nos.7 and 8 for brokering the deal but no such plot existed in the names of respondent Nos.4, 5 and 6.

Keeping in view the allegations in the complaint/representation dated 10.04.2017 (Annexure P-3), a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala and Station House Officer, Police Station Kotwali, District Patiala, respondent Nos.3 and 4 respectively, to look into the complaint and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.

With the above observations, the petition stands disposed of.
