Petitioner claims herself to be major. She fell ill in the year 2016-17, for which she was treated by one Devaji a spritual lady. Petitioner showed lot of improvement in her health and wanted to be desciple of aforesaid lady known as Devaji. Petitioner has alleged some allegations against the private respondents for which a representation was filed by her on 15.03.2018 before respondent No.2.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl, AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any reply from respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, this petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the representation (Annexure P2) dated 15.03.2018 made by the petitioner and act in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of facts recorded hereinabove.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
