Both the above-mentioned cases are taken up together as these
have arisen from same FIR.

Petitioners have filed these petitions under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 775 dated 10.11.2017
registered under Sections 3/13 (1), 8/13(3) of the Haryana Gauvansh
Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act 2015, at Police Station Nuh, District
Mewat, Haryana.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the petitions.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version FIR was registered on the basis of secret information. When the police party raided the spot, two persons started running near a cutting bull and ran away after jumping the wall towards the hill.

The petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for investigation or interrogation purposes. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody. Nothing is to be recovered from them.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find it a fit case, where petitioners are entitled to benefit of grant of anticipatory bail. Therefore, both the petitions are accepted and the order dated 26.03.2018 passed in CRM No.M-12466 of 2018 and order dated 22.05.2018 passed in CRM No.M-22059 of 2018 granting interim bail to the petitioners, are made absolute.
