By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of bail, he having been arrested pursuant to FIR no.13, dated 01.02.2018, being registered at Police Station Division No.2, Jalandhar, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 307/341/506/148/149 of the IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act.

Mr. Navkiran Singh, learned counsel appearing for the complainant, does not deny that the matter has actually been compromised between the parties and in fact CRM-10117-2018 has also been listed alongwith this case, by which the present petitioner and his co-accused seek quashing of the FIR itself, on the basis of such compromise.

That being so, as regards the present petition, though the allegations against the petitioner are obviously serious, however, he already having been in custody for about 3 ½ months, with a compromise having

been reached, I consider it appropriate to admit him to bail, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the committing Court/trial Court (depending upon where proceedings are pending).
