JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 111 dated 18.05.2017, under Sections 304-B and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Mullana, District Ambala.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and he is in custody since 19.05.2017. Counsel for the petitioner also relies upon the post-mortem report which clearly indicates that there were no external injuries present on the body of the deceased, however, it was alleged in the FIR that she was beaten up before administering poison to her. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner should be enlarged on regular bail keeping in view the above facts and that the trial is likely to take some time.

Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana, has appeared on behalf

of respondent-State and Mr. B. K. Majoka has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant. Counsel for the respondent-State and counsel for the complainant oppose the grant of regular bail by submitting that the photographs would reveal that the deceased has been subjected to cruelty and beatings at the hands of the petitioner. This fact is denied by the counsel for the petitioner who submits that post-mortem report does not reveal any external injuries.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner is in custody since 19.05.2017 and the trial is likely to take some time, no useful purpose would be served in keeping him in custody furthermore. Hence, the present petition is accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, any opinion expressed herein is for the purpose of grant of regular bail and not an opinion on the merits of the case.
