Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case F.I.R. No.115, dated 15.10.2017, under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, a commercial vehicle was intercepted on the basis of secret information and an alleged recovery of 600 kgs. of poppy husk was effected. Co-accused, Baljeet Singh @ Buntty and Sanjeev Kumar @ Sonu were apprehended on the spot. There is no recovery that has been effected from the present petitioner and nor he was apprehended on the spot. He is sought to be roped in on the strength of Section 29 of the NDPS Act.

Investigation in the case is complete and challan has been presented.

Petitioner has faced incarceration since 31.10.2017.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is

allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned provided that he is not required in custody in any other case.

Petition disposed of.
