AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court for directing respondent No.2 to transfer the investigation in FIR No.313 dated 29.09.2017 registered under Sections 167, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar, Hansi, to some senior police officer of the rank of Superintendent of Police as the investigation is not being fairly conducted.

From the perusal of the FIR, it appears to be a family dispute between the parties, where the allegations have been made that the daughter-in-law has wrongly submitted certain documents and information claiming herself to be the sole legal heir of the deceased, whereas the mother of the deceased was also entitled to, as per the allegations.

It is contended that six months have passed and the investigation till date has not been completed.

Since it is a matter which needs to be gone into details, obviously it takes some time.

This Court finds no reason to transfer the investigation merely on the basis of such allegations, as have been made in the present petition.

The petition, therefore, stands dismissed at this stage.
