ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 5, dated 10.01.2018, under Sections 307, 452, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the petitioner is named in the FIR but he has not been ascribed any role and no injury is attributed to him.

Learned counsel for the complainant, however, contends that the petitioner is also involved in another FIR.

A Co-ordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 26.03.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions

envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jatinder Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 26.03.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner having joined investigation and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 26.03.2018, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
