**AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J.(ORAL)**

Learned counsel for the petitioner points to the fact that even as per the case of the prosecution, only one injury on the right bicep to the deceased is attributed to the petitioner, with a baton.

Learned State counsel however submits that when this Court was not inclined to grant bail to co-accused Kuldeep Singh @ Gandhi, counsel for the said co-accused had withdrawn CRM-M-9953-2018 on 23.03.2018.

Having considered the above, though an offence punishable under Section 120-B IPC is also stated to have been added later in the FIR, considering the nature of injury attributed to the petitioner, and the fact that none of the prosecution witnesses out of 29 has been examined so far, without making any comment on merits either for or against the petitioner, I consider it appropriate to admit him to bail upon his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.

Ordered accordingly.
