This appeal has been filed against that portion of the judgment of the Employees Insurance Court whereby the demand for contribution under the head Director's office allowance has been accepted.

The appellant had made a demand to the respondent on account of one payment of ₹ 3915/- which was made under the head Director's office allowance. There were other demands also. The computation was challenged by the respondent. The other demands were rejected but the claim relating to the payment made for Director's office allowance was accepted and that is why the appellant is before this Court.

Counsel for the appellant has not been able to argue how the

payment for Director's office allowance would come within the ambit of the Employees Insurance Act. Consequently, this appeal is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
