None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Similar was the position on the last date of hearing.

Vide order dated 26.3.2018, the petitioner was directed to appear in the trial Court within 7 days from that date, with the observations that on his doing so and moving an application for regular bail, the same be disposed of by the trial Court expeditiously. Counsel for the petitioner was directed to report compliance by the next date fixed as 25.4.2018, making it clear that in case of non-compliance the petition would be liable to be dismissed. On the adjourned date, counsel had appeared and stated that petitioner had surrendered in the trial Court and had been granted regular bail. He sought some time to place on file certified copy of that order. The

case was adjourned to 15.5.2018. On that date, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Similar is the position today.

Under the circumstances, the petition stands dismissed.
