Learned counsel for the petitioners refers to report dated 29.09.2017, regarding C.T. scan of petitioner No.5 and submits that he has suffered fracture in his skull and therefore, he has suffered a grievous injury.

The petitioners seek direction to respondent No.2 to protect their lives and liberty, which is allegedly threatened by respondent Nos.5 to 10 and to initiate legal action against them.

The case of the petitioners is that the private respondents are threatening their lives and liberty on account of political affiliations. They have caused injuries earlier also, but no action has been taken by the police, even though, the matter has been reported to it. Now, a detailed representation dated 15.02.2018 (Annexure P4) has been submitted, yet, no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. J.S. Walia, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. Let five copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.5 to 10, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P4) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
