Petitioner seeks concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.14, dated 04.04.2012, under Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Kathgarh, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

During the course of arguments, counsel concedes that the petitioner having absented from trial proceedings was declared a proclaimed offender on 15.10.2014.

Counsel has also fairly conceded that during the trial proceedings, petitioner had proceeded abroad.

It is a case where the petitioner has mis-used the concession of bail that had been granted to him and had left abroad without even seeking permission from the competent Court.

Conduct of the petitioner dis-entitles him from the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is dismissed.
