Instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of interim bail to the petitioner for a period of 10 days.

Counsel submits that marriage of the sister of the petitioner is fixed for 31.03.2018 and being the real brother his presence at the ceremony would be required.

During the course of arguments, counsel concedes that parents of the petitioner are alive and that he has another male sibling.

Notice in the petition.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Jaspreet Kaur, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Petitioner is one of the main accused in FIR No.79 dated 28.04.2017, under Sections 308, 325, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar (Punjab) and is currently lodged in Central Jail, Amritsar.

The genesis of the occurrence is stated to be the construction of a ramp and amongst neighbours in a village. Offence under Sections 308 and 325 IPC have also been cited.

Counsel at this stage confines the prayer in the petition

to be permitted to attend the marriage of his sister on 31.03.2018 and in police custody.

In the light of such request, there would be no requirement for seeking a formal reply at the hands of the State to the instant petition. The marriage card of Kanwaljit Kaur i.e. sister of the petitioner has been placed on record.

The limited prayer raised by counsel is found to be just and reasonable.

The instant petition is accordingly disposed of with the directions to State of Punjab/jail authorities, Central Jail, Amritsar to make necessary arrangements for the petitioner to participate in the marriage ceremony of his sister on 31.03.2018 at Village Bandala, District Tarn Taran.

Petitioner would be taken in police custody to the venue of the wedding at 09:00 a.m. on 31.03.2018 and shall be brought back to Jail/custody at 05:00 p.m. on the same very day.

Petition disposed of.
