The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.26 dated 31.01.2018, registered under Sections 307, 452, 323, 427, 379-B, 148, 149, 506 IPC at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has submitted that earlier the petitioner is not named in the FIR but subsequently he was named in the FIR on the basis of supplementary statement of the petitioner. He has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 27.03.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
