This is 2nd petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.05 dated 24.01.2018 under Sections 341, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar, Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur.

The first petition was dismissed as withdrawn on 14.03.2018, after counsel for the petitioner argued the case in presence of counsel for the complainant as well as learned State counsel.

Though no fresh ground is made out, however, the arguments on merits were heard again. As per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner has given a rod blow on the stomach of the complainant Gurpreet Singh and his mobile phone fell down.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has again argued that the

injury attributed to the petitioner is not attracting Section 326 IPC. This argument was duly considered when the first application was argued and later on, it was withdrawn by counsel for the petitioner.

Considering the nature of injuries sustained by the complainant at the hands of the accused persons, including the injury attributed to the petitioner, I find no ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
