Petitioner-Bhura Singh has filed this second petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.77 dated 25.05.2017, registered at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa, under Sections 171, 307 and 420 IPC, Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 467, 468 and 471 IPC added later on.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that first of all, in the present case, no injury has been declared dangerous to life. There is no injury suffered

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by any person. The only allegation against the present petitioner is that he fired a shot from the pistol, but it did not hit to anybody. As regards Sections 467, 468 and 471 IPC, the allegation is that the accused were having fake number plate on the vehicle etc.

The petitioner has been in custody since 25.05.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
