Learned counsel for the petitioners points to the order of this Court dated 08.02.2018, passed in CRM-M-4465-2018, granting bail to the person actually named as the prime accused in the alleged murder of Ranjit Kaur, i.e. Harmanpreet Singh, on whose disclosure statement the petitioners are stated to have been named as his accomplices in murder.

Though learned State counsel opposes the bail application stating that even the Aadhar Card of one of the petitioners was found at the spot, as per the case of the prosecution, with learned counsel for the petitioners naturally controverting that to say that it was planted and that nothing of the sort found mention in the FIR, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioners, simply looking at the period of custody as undertrials, with the trial not being anywhere near conclusion, I consider it appropriate to admit them to bail, on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction

of the trial Court, especially as the prime accused has already been admitted to bail by this Court.

Ordered accordingly.
