Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary direction to respondents No.1 to 5 in the context of protecting his life and personal liberty from being invaded at the hands of respondent No.6.

Mother-in-law of the petitioner is the author of a criminal complaint against her co-villagers. A cross version was recorded in the said FIR, wherein in-laws family of the petitioner was also implicated. Petitioner has nothing to do with the said case. Petitioner has pleaded incriminating allegations against respondent No.6 who is SHO, Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

Precisely, for the grievance in question, petitioner has also moved a representation dated 08.03.2018 before respondents No.2 to 5.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any reply from respondents/State .

At this stage, this petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.5 to have a fair look on the representation dated 08.03.2018 made by the petitioner and act in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of facts recorded hereinabove.
