The petitioner seeks protection of life, liberty and property at the hands of respondent No. 4.

The allegations are that the petitioner is owner of certain land within municipal limit Karnal. Respondent No. 4 approached the petitioner and told him that he has purchased the land vide agreement to sell dated 28.12.2017 and that possession be handed over to him. Infact, respondent No. 4 is found to have forcible possession of the land whereas he has no concern therewith. It is further alleged that respondent No. 4 has links with Gundas and can harm the petitioner and his family. A representation dated 29.12.2017 (Annexure P-1) was made in this regard. No action has been taken thereupon and, therefore, another representation dated 13.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) was made. Yet, the police is not taking any action.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pardeep Sharma, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order that is being passed there is no necessity

~~to issue notice to respondent No. 4 at this stage.~~

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No. 2 to consider representation dated 13.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) objectively and by associating the petitioner with the enquiry. In case it appears that threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members is revealed, appropriate action be taken in accordance with law within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
